ΘΕΜΑΤΑ

SURGERY abroad may sometimes be cheaper but standards in Eastern European countries and Greece in particular are notoriously sloppy. This is the view of Professor David Sharpe, a former president of the British Association of Aesthetic Plastic Surgeons.

“What you find in parts of [Europe] is that it’s quite a lot easier to get on the specialist register, especially in Greece”, he said.

“There are problems in places like Poland in that accreditation is not strictly regulated and doctors may not even have any qualifications in plastic surgery.

“Over here most plastic surgeons will have worked in the NHS* and will have been brought up in a culture of putting patients first.

“The average plastic surgeon here will be looking after burnt children, cancer patients and so on and the ethics are quite different”.

In America the soaring cost of malpractice insurance means that there is much more competition for patients.

Professor Sharpe said it was best to steer clear of plastic surgeons who have to advertise because most good plastic surgeons have to turn work away.

If surgery abroad goes wrong it can be difficult to pursue a case through the courts. Patients need to find a local lawyer, then an expert witness who speaks the language.
